

Making dental care for your pet easy & affordable



- Why is pet dental care important, and how can we help you keep the costs reasonable?

Dental care is important for several reasons:

- Dental disease is painful. Our pets are good at hiding their pain. Have you had toothache? If your pet has established dental disease – it is hurting, possibly a lot! We need to prevent that.
 - Your pet will probably still be eating. Eating is essential if you don't eat, you die.
- Dental care gets more expensive as dental disease gets worse. Preventive care is the best way to keep the costs down.
 - Dental treatment for a grade 4 mouth (the picture) would start at around \$800
- Dental disease is a threat to general health your pet's heart, skin & many other areas of the body are more prone to infection when there is established dental disease.
- ~ Dental disease is ugly & smells bad.

We use dental grades to record the dental status

Grade 0 is the perfect mouth, Gr 2 is mild disease (we need to do something at this point) & Grade 4 we
never want to see

So – how can we help you manage this? What is the Latrobe Veterinary Group Dental Health Plan?

Your part:

- Be proactive about dental care & follow your vet's recommendations as far as possible
 Discuss any problems with our staff there are many options for dental care
- Show up with your pet every 6 months for your FREE dental checks, which can be with other visits to clinic for your convenience (you do need to make an appointment)

Our part:

- ~ FREE 6 monthly dental checks, lifelong, while your pet is on the Dental Health Plan
- \sim 15% off dental care products, while your pet stays on the Dental Health Plan
- \sim Gr I-2 dentals as preventative at the fixed price when vet determines necessary
 - Currently \$300 for cats, \$350 for dogs
- \$300 off your pet's first dental if Gr 3-4 to make it easier to join the Dental Health Plan
 This is not repeated under any circumstances
